Be Ferry Aware

Parents and Junior Lifeguards,

As summer begins we look forward to seeing you and your children come across the Ferry as part of the Jr. Lifeguard Program. We ask that you please go over this information together to ensure we have a very safe and efficient summer.

- 1) Always walk when on the docks and the Ferry. If riding a bike, please get off before the crosswalk and look both ways for pedestrians before crossing to the dock.
- 2) Follow the crew instructions during loading and unloading. We will only bring on as many passengers as we can collect from during a crossing. Please wait if asked to, another Ferry will be along shortly.



3) Please have your money out and ready after you sit down. While we can make change, it will help us get you over to the other side much quicker if you have exact change. A reminder of our fares:

CHILD (5-11) \$0.50-----WITH BICYCLE \$0.75
ADULT (12+) \$1.25-----WITH BICYCLE \$1.50
CAR AND DRIVER \$2.25 + PASSENGER FARE

4) Do not run around the boat hiding from the collecting deckhand. We can see you. If any passenger develops a reputation of being a problem, they may be asked to no longer ride the Ferry

5) It is never acceptable to jump off the boat. Jumping off the boat can lead to very serious injury and/or a ban from the Ferry. Any instance of someone jumping off the Ferry must be reported to the United States Coast Guard, and the individual who jumps overboard may be fined.



6) Parents, please remind children to wear the sandals and shoes they bring as the deck will become hot in the afternoon sun.

Any unsafe and irresponsible behavior will be reported to the Jr. Lifeguard Program with the hopes of keeping transportation safe and consistent for the rest of the participants. It is our goal at the Balboa Island Ferry to provide safe and expedient service to your children and I want to thank you for choosing the Ferry to get your children to and from the peninsula.
