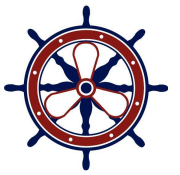




# BALBOA ISLAND FERRY



Welcome to the 2026 summer season! Please review the following to help ensure your JG has a safe and smooth Ferry experience riding with us.

**1) Arrive early:** At least 45 minutes early. The Ferry operates on a “first come, first served” basis, and passenger space is limited. The Catalina Flyer departs at 8:45 a.m. daily and 12:30 p.m. on Mondays. Junior Lifeguards will be sharing the Ferry with Catalina Flyer passengers at these times.

**2) Bikes/E-Bikes.**

- Stop at stop signs.
- Dismount bike and walk **before** Agate Ave. alley.
- Look both ways for pedestrians prior to crossing the boardwalk.
- **E-Bikes must be in the “OFF” position on the Ferries and docks.**

**3) Follow Ferry Crew instructions.** Do not board or exit while vehicles are moving.

**4) Have your fare ready.** Having exact change will help get you across quicker.

2026 Fares:	
• Child (5-11) \$1.00.....	with bicycle \$1.25
• Adult (12+) \$2.00.....	with bicycle \$2.25
• Car and Driver \$3.00 +	passenger fare

**5) Fare evasion prohibited** and will result in denied service.

**6) Parents:** Do not use Agate or adjacent alleys for drop-off/pick-up. JG’s can walk along the boardwalk from other drop-off locations

**7) Vehicles must carry passengers safely.** Vehicles with passengers in truck beds, on rooftops, and other areas not designed for passengers will not be admitted.

**8) No jumping off the Ferry.** Violations may result in a permanent ban and US Coast Guard fines up to \$30,000.

**9) Footwear is required at all times.** No bare feet, no running.

**Be advised, unsafe behavior will be reported** to Junior Lifeguard leadership and subject to dismissal from the program.

Thank you for choosing the Historic Balboa Island Ferry. It’s our goal to get you Junior Lifeguard safely to and from their program.
